Students will be selected based on the value of the program or project to their studies in English language and literature. Priority will be given to first-time study abroad participants, especially those enrolling in Departmental programs.

Students must be English majors who are enrolled full-time at K.U. A committee will evaluate applications.

This scholarship has two rolling deadlines, October first and March first. The scholarship will be awarded twice a year to a nominee who submits all materials by one of the two deadlines.
